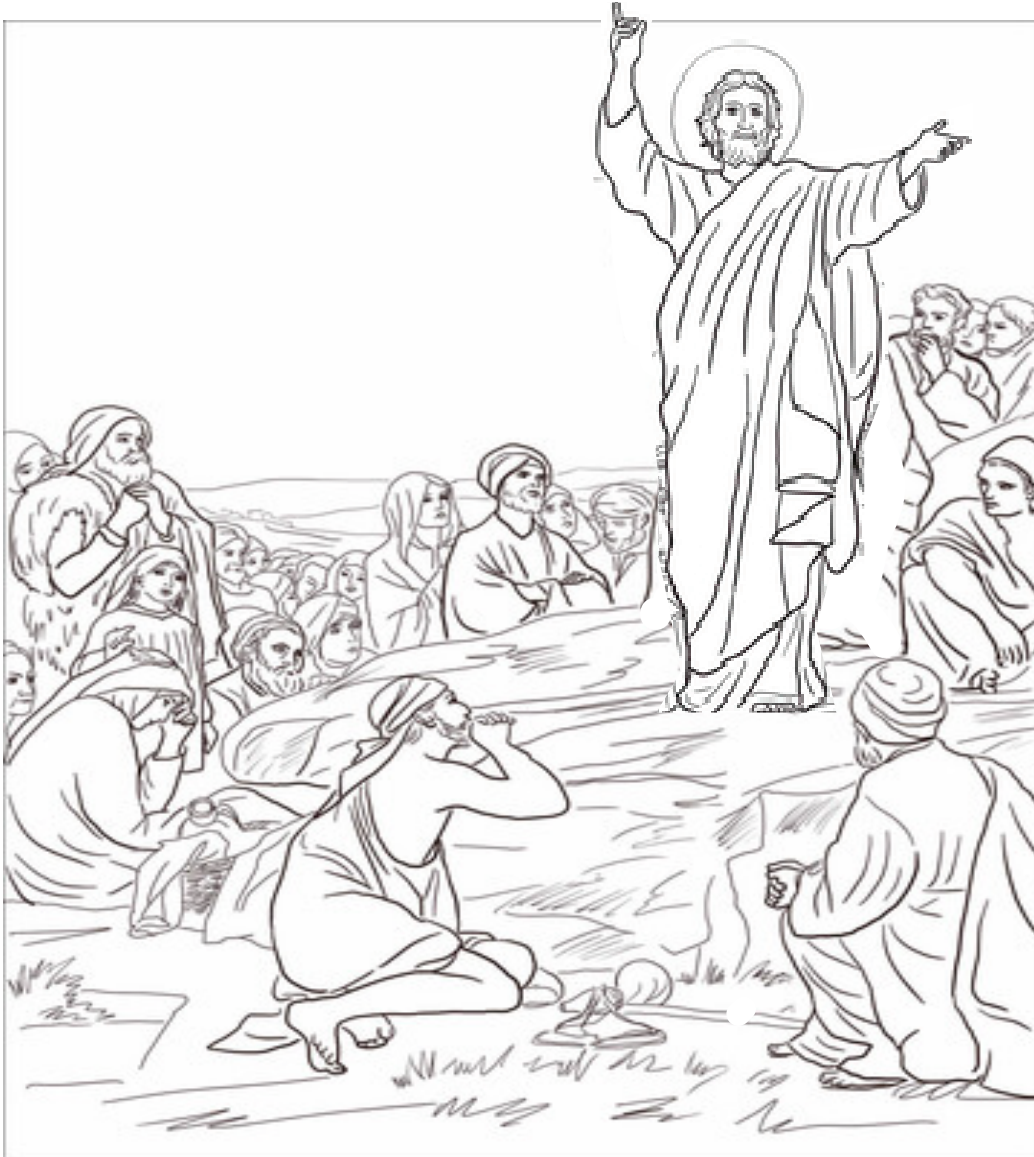


# Catholic Kid's Corner

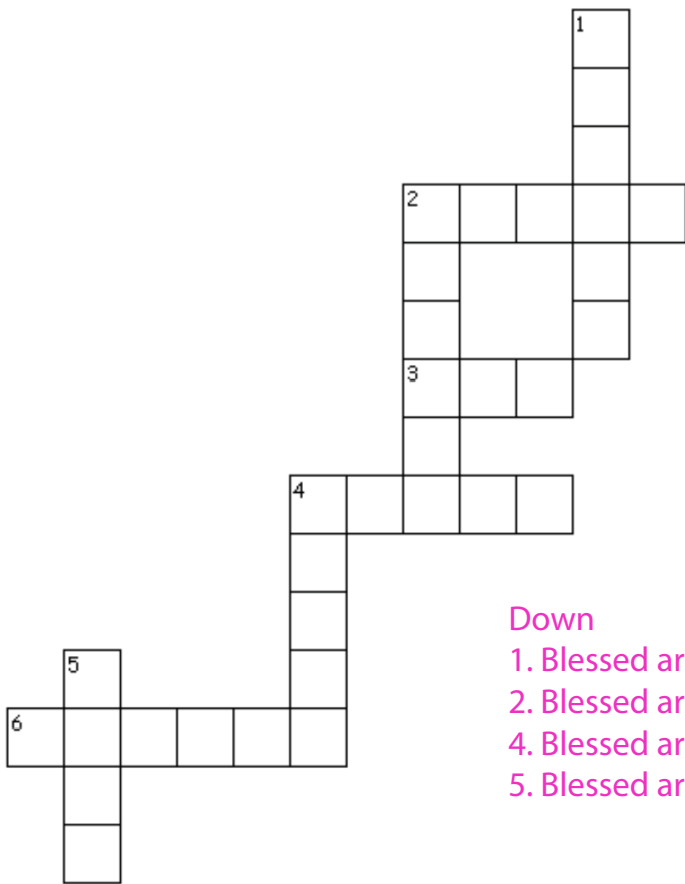
